ERL Journal follows the rule of transparency and best practice for scholarly publications mention in regulations provided by the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), the Directory of Open Access Journal (DOAJ), the Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association (OASPA), and the World Association of Medical Editors (WAME). ERL Journal is an Open Access publication by the International Association for the Educational Role of Language. Publications, which are required to follow the journal guidelines, are free of charge and must undergo a double blind peer review process.
