She teaches the course English Language and ELT II in the Degree in Primary Education in English and ELT Methodology in the English Minor of such Degree. This is related to her first line of research: ELT Teaching, [foreign] language acquisition and learning, CLIL, bilingual education, dual-language immersion and plurilingualism, which at the same time branches with ERL strands of Language and Culture and Language and Methodology in general, and bilingualism, plurilingualism and teaching, CLIL and ESP in particular. She also teaches Innovation and Research in Language and Literature and their Teaching in the Master's Degree in Education Research and Innovation, particularly the unit concerning the Study of the English Language. This is focused on linguistics, which is related to such line of research as well as applied linguistics, sociolinguistics, pragmatics, cognitive linguistics, discourse analysis and attenuation and offense in discourse. This second line is linked to ERL scopes of Language and Schooling (learning, class talk, language of schooling and academic language), Language and Culture (slang, jargon, pragmatics and speech act) and Language and Methodology (discourse analysis and action research). Finally, she teaches Education Innovation in Modern Languages in the Master's Degree in Secondary Education, Upper Secondary Education, Vocational Training and Foreign Language Teaching. Her research interests in this respect are education innovation and research, ICT, trends in innovation and European Education programmes, which are at the same time related to ERL strands of Language and Schooling (assessment, textbooks, curricular, learning), Language and Culture (interculturality and bilingualism) and Language and Methodology (teaching, CLIL, research, ESP).
