<u>'Language as Foundations of Democracy'</u>



SUBSTANCE overall logic The primary premise of the Call is that language as a key element of democracy (its formation and its solidification) is frequently taken for granted, which is not a pro-democratic approach to language per se. Democracy needs conscious reflection and balanced discussions on the language applied in the public sphere of everyday life. Real democracy remains open to various ways of describing reality, with none of the means used being superior over other possibilities.
